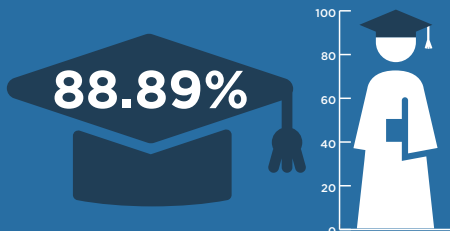

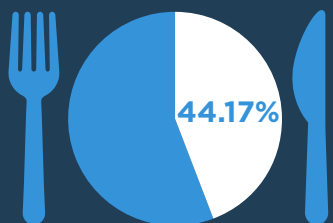

**STUDENT RACE/ETHNICITY<sup>1</sup>**



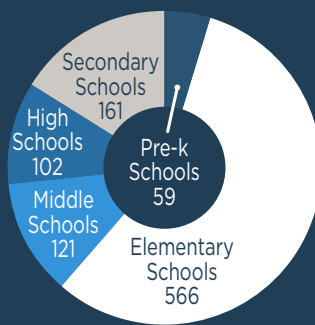

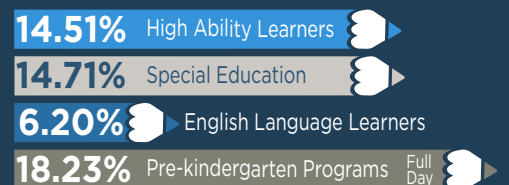

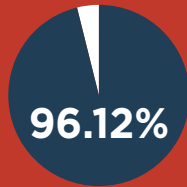

 Number of CTE Concentrators Who Passed Technical Skill Assessments Aligned with Industry-Recognized Standards

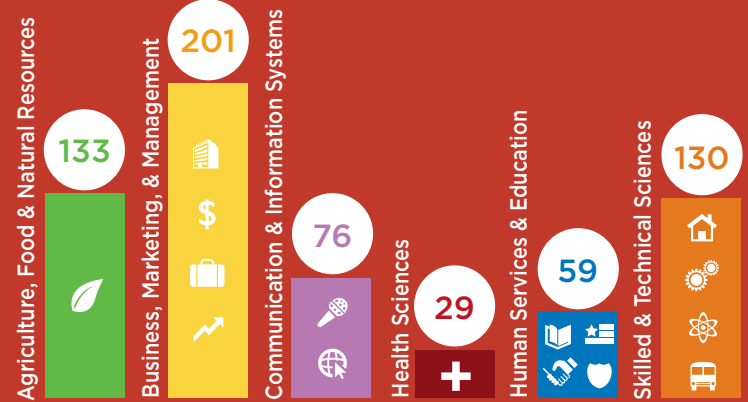
### PLACEMENT<sup>7</sup>

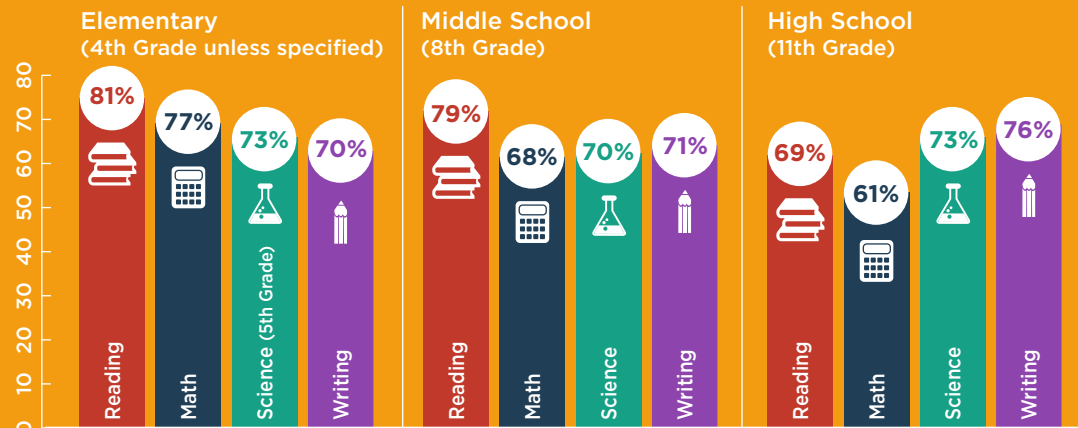
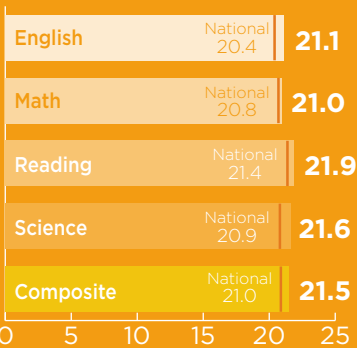
