PERMIT TO ADMINISTER MEDICATION

In order for school personnel to administer medication to a student, it is necessary to have written permission from a parent or guardian. A permit is required for the dispensing of any medication, including Tylenol and other over-the-counter type medications. School policy requires that the following conditions be met before a medication will be dispensed:

1. A signed permit is submitted to the school nurse or principal.
2. Prescribed medication to be administered must be in a prescription container, properly labeled, including: child's name, physician's name, name of medication and directions for administering. Your pharmacist will provide you with an extra medication container if you ask.
3. Over-the-counter medications must be in original manufacturer's container.

No medications will be administered past their expiration date.
