GRADING: *A grade should reflect what a student **knows and is able to do** in a course. Non-academic factors are valuable but will be communicated separately. This includes attendance, attitude, behavior in class, and completion of homework. All grading and reporting is to be based on the standards and NOT on a curve.—PHS grading policy*

- Grading: (15%)(Formative Assessments) + (75%)(Summative Assessments) + (10%)(Final Exam)

1. **Summative Assessments:** *Work must be done in pencil and all work must be shown to receive credit.*

- Students who are absent the day of a previously announced assessment will be expected to turn in or make up the assessment upon their return to class.
- Students who miss the review day, but are present on the day of an exam must receive permission from his/her teacher PRIOR to class time to be excused from the exam on that day.
- Students will be expected to finish all assessments within the class period or given time frame, unless he/she has an IEP or other written documentation that states otherwise.
- *If a student is not proficient (<60%) on an assessment, they will be reassessed after doing a self-assessment and re-teaching. —PCSD District Policy.* The re-take must take place at least one day prior to the next unit test.
 - **Re-teaching:** This may include test corrections done in the classroom, correcting or finishing assignments (not for credit) from the unit, and/or one other practice assignment (IXL, MathTrainer, etc.)
- If a student is proficient (>60%) on an assessment and would like to re-take the assessment they will be able to if: they have not retaken any other unit test during the semester, have completed all of the assignments for the unit prior to the original test date, and after they've received the teacher's approval. The re-take must take place at least one day prior to the next unit test.

2. **Formative Assessments:** *Work must be done in pencil and all work must be shown to receive credit.*

- Students should expect an assignment daily.
- See grading rubric for guidelines.
- Homework will be checked daily and students will make any corrections to their work in a colored pen.
- Credit for homework is based on completion, correct procedure and having all work shown for every problem assigned.
- Late work will be accepted for partial credit and must be turned in prior to the unit test. If you turn it in without a name or proper heading it will be thrown away!

Absences:

If at any time a student misses class for any reason, it will be the **student's responsibility** to find out what information was covered and when it needs to be made up. If the student is gone for a school activity, homework must be made up prior to the absence unless otherwise stated by your teacher.
